

Weather Report

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| This is | An activity to familiarize members with each other and to break the ice before a meeting |
| The purpose is | To grow continuity amongst members and create an open atmosphere for discussion |
| Use this when | You need an ice-breaker to start a meeting or notice that your chapter members aren't getting to know each other and you want to bring your chapter closer together |
| Materials you'll need | A list of questions relating crazy weather (Ex: Have you ever been in a Tornado?) |
| Here's how | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Split the group up into two teams • Get each team to circle up • Tell one group to get in a tight circle and have everyone facing OUTWARD • Tell the other group to circle up around the other circle facing INWARD • Make sure that people from the outside circle are paired up with the inside circle • Prompt them with a question about crazy weather and instruct members to introduce themselves and discuss the question • Allow for discussion and tell the inside circle to turn to the right so they are facing a new person • Repeat the last two bullet points until the game is complete (Use different Questions) |
| Ask these questions | <p>Have you ever been in a tornado?</p> <p>What is the windiest place you have ever been?</p> <p>Have you ever experienced snow more than 2 ft. tall. If so, where?</p> <p><i>Feel free to make up more on your own!</i></p> |
| Tips for success | <p>Allow for discussion after members have finished talking about the weather.</p> <p>After the activity is over ask an individual person what the craziest story they heard was.</p> <p>Feel free to talk about more than just the weather (Try the same game but talk about another topic)</p> |
